MINISTRY DEVELOPMENT

s our SCC Churches move further into the Spirit-led, Mission-driven organizational paradigm, we will begin to see less "one-size-fits-all" departmental structures within our churches, and more churches with contextualized and creative ministries based upon the unique needs present in their communities, and the spiritual gifts present in their churches. This means every church will not attempt to do everything—nor should they. Instead, the Spirit will lead each church to develop ministries that best execute their church's mission in their specific context. As ministry coaches, the Church Ministries & Mission Development Team will seek to identify and share ministry best practices, as well as provide ministry expertise, to assist pastors and their church leaders with the development and implementation of Spirit-led, Mission-driven ministries. Some of the recommended ministries will be traditional, others will be non-traditional—but all are to be viewed as ministry options rather than ministry requirements.

mentally, physically, and socially to impact their homes, their churches, and the world around us." The vision is


