
PRAYER DEVELOPMENT

How to become a living, working Church

llen White writes: "The religion of Christ means more than the forgiveness of sin; it means that sin is taken away, and that the vacuum is filled with the Spirit. It means that the mind is divinely illumined, that the heart is emptied of self, and filled with the presence of Christ. When this work is done for church members, the church will be a living, working church....The baptism of the Holy Spirit, and nothing less, can bring us to this place" (Review and Herald, June 10, 1902). In other words, she's saying for our churches to be "Mission-driven," we must first become "Spirit-filled!"

Therefore, we began the year with

our UPPER ROOM Conference, and are now continuing with UPPER ROOM Small Groups, all to assist pastors and their church leaders in leading their churches to become more Spirit-led and Mission-driven. Altogether, there are now 6 SCC churches/districts—the New Life (Nashville, TN), Lima Drive (Lexington, KY), and Longview Heights (Memphis, TN) churches; and the Natchez-Woodville, Gulfport-Mobile, and Pensacola-Atmore districts, who have completed, or are currently engaged in, UPPER ROOM emphases where members are praying to be born of the Spirit, filled with the Spirit, and led by the Spirit into mission!



An 8-week UPPER ROOM journey can easily occur during your church's weekly Prayer Meeting. Our Church Ministries & Mission Development Team will provide free copies of the book "The Baptism of the Holy Spirit" for each participant, and if desired, a facilitator to conduct the series. - 3. **INVITE** extending an invitation to others to be part of Christ's family through lovingly meeting their physical and spiritual needs.

PRISON MINISTRY

e are pleased to welcome to our Church Ministries & Mission Development Team Pastor Ricky Wade, assistant pastor of the New Life SDA Church in Huntsville AL, as our new South Central Conference Prison Ministry Leader! Pastor Wade says, "Prison

ministry is personal for me because I know firsthand what it means to be stripped of your dignity and pride because of a bad decision. It means that you hit bottom, one that is lonely and surrounded by others who have made bad decisions. It means looking for a friend in a place where true friendship is difficult to find. Jail and prison are two places where choices are reduced to a minimum and trust is a rare commodity. The search



for a meaningful purpose that involves worship and fellowship and studies that reveal God happen regularly. Every inmate is looking for purpose, a place to fit in that has meaning and a sense of belonging. They long for family and seek opportunities to be wanted. Prison ministry is a place

where we can provide love and truth that sets people free."

There are many ways that churches can engage in prison ministry, from putting funds on an inmate's phone card and simply listening during regular calls, to writing words of encouragement in weekly letters. 
